The conference aims to develop the scientific heritage of the outstanding Russian sinologist **Oleg Markovich Gotlib** (10/20/1951 - 06/08/2016) through the exchange of scientific results and research experience in the field of fundamental and current aspects of oriental studies and regional studies of the Asia-Pacific region in the light of the current level of problem posing and methods for solving them in context of the development of transdisciplinary knowledge. The conference is dedicated to the 75th anniversary of the founding of the People's Republic of China and the establishment of Russian-Chinese relations.

Main areas of work:

1. Theory, methodology, practice of oriental studies and regional studies of Asia-Pacific countries.
2. Prospects for the development of transdisciplinary regional studies, regional studies, regional studies, regional studies, local studies and other related regional disciplines.

Advanced training courses within the framework of the conference:

Within the framework of the conference, it is planned to conduct advanced training courses with the issuance of a standard certificate on the topic "Asia-Pacific region: linguistics, linguodidactics, regional studies, oriental studies" in the amount of 18 hours, full-time and remote formats are provided. The cost of participation is 3500 rubles. The courses are full-time, but they will be conducted using e-learning and distance technologies, which will allow everyone to undergo training without being present in the city of Irkutsk. During the conference, special lectures on this topic will be held for course participants. To register for advanced training courses you must:

PUBLICATION OF THE CONFERENCE COLLECTION

Publication of the conference collection:

The organizing committee reserves the right to reject copyright materials that do not meet the content and technical requirements. The publication date for the collection of conference materials is October 2024.

Requirements for the design of materials:

- Volume of work – from 4 to 10 pages of A4 printed text.
- Font size – 14 point, Times New Roman,

line spacing is single, all margins are 2 cm, paragraph indent size is 1.25 cm. Emphasis used is bold, italic, bold italic.

- On the first page on the right above the title of the article the following is indicated: UDC (detailed, for example, 811.521), full name, city (in brackets), institution. The title of the article is located in the center and is highlighted in capital letters; if there is a subtitle, in lowercase letters.

- For hieroglyphs, only one font should be used throughout the text. Recommended fonts for hieroglyphs: SimSun, Batang, Mincho, MS Mincho, MS PMincho.

- Abstract – about 500 printed characters.

- Keywords – no more than 10.

- FULL NAME. author, title, abstract, keywords

dubbed in English. The font size of the annotation and keywords is the same as in the main text.

- Links to the source of citations in the text are presented in square brackets, for example, [Ivanov, 2008, p. 41], [Petrova, 2006, p. 120–122], if the publication does not have an author, then according to the first word in the description of the work, for example, [History..., 2000].

- A bibliography is provided at the end of the publication in alphabetical order. Footnotes are provided at the end of the publication. The font size in the bibliography and footnotes is the same as in the main text. The list of references can only contain those sources that are referenced in the text of the article.

- The use of hyphens, page breaks, and additional spaces is not allowed.
