PUBLICATION OF THE CONFERENCE MATERIALS

Publication of the Conference Materials:

The Organizing Committee reserves the right to reject copyrighted materials that do not meet the content and format requirements. The authors are responsible for the absence of plagiarism in the submitted materials, while the original text should be at least 70%, the citation should not exceed 30%, and there should be no incorrect borrowings in the text. An anti-plagiarism report should be attached to the submitted materials by the author.

The publication date of the Conference materials is spring 2026.

Format Requirements for the materials:

- The length of work is from 4 to 10 A4 pages of printed text.
- Font size – 14 pt, Times New Roman, line spacing – single, all margins – 2 cm (0.8 inches), paragraph indent – 1.25 cm (0.5 inches). The highlights can be bold, italics, and bold italics.
- On the first page to the right above the title of the article, the following are indicated: UDC (detailed, for example, 811.521), full name, city (in parentheses), and institution. The title of the article is centered and highlighted in CAPITAL letters, with a subtitle in lowercase letters.
- For hieroglyphs, only one font should be used throughout the text. Recommended fonts for hieroglyphs: SimSun, Batang, Mincho, MS Mincho, MS PMincho.
- Abstract – about 500 printed characters.
- Keywords – no more than 10.
- The full name of the author, title, abstract, and keywords are duplicated in English. The font size of the annotation and keywords is the same as in the main text.
- References to the source of citation in the text are placed in square brackets, for example, [Ivanov, 2008, p. 41], [Petrova, 2006, p. 120-122], if the publication does not have an author, then by the first word in the description of the work, for example, [History ..., 2000].
- The bibliographic list is given at the end of the publication in alphabetical order: first, the sources are in Russian, then in English, then in other languages. The lists in Eastern languages are given after the sources in European languages, and their order should correspond to the transcription systems generally accepted for a particular language. Footnotes are provided at the end of the publication. The font size in the bibliographic list and footnotes is the same as in the main text. The list of references can include only those sources that are referenced in the text of the article itself; all sources that are not referenced will be removed from the bibliographic list.
- Hyphenation, page breaks, and additional spaces are not allowed. For a sample of the design of the article and the bibliographic list, see Application.
